Our item below includes a link to the first article on Synodality, "Walking Together," as the Greek word means. In our May e-letter, I mentioned the two triangles at the bottom of the home page of the Mission-Unity-Dialogue website. If you have not looked at that, you might want to consider what these two triangles mean.

The feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus occurs this year on Friday, June 24. Many older Catholics remember how God revealed the loving Heart of His Son to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in France in 1673-75. It immediately was perceived as a powerful antidote to the poison of Jansenism. Jansenism required Catholics to be perfect before they could receive Communion at Mass. At the same time, Protestantism was being infected by the poison of extreme Puritanism, which reduced the mercy of God towards Protestants.

May we celebrate the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus with all love and eagerness. His love will help us see in the long process of synodality, another way that Christianity is coming closer to the Heart of Jesus.
